TEZPUR COLLEGE AT A GLANCE

To meet the growing need for a higher education institution in Tezpur, Tezpur College opened its doors on August 5, 1965, thanks to the tireless efforts of some visionary residents of Tezpur, especially late Dulal Chandra Bhattacharjee, late Padma Prasad, and late Haramba Sarmah. The institution made its humble beginning on the premises of Tezpur Academy in the form of evening classes. In 1968, the college was moved to its current location next to the Central Jail. Under the capable direction of the late Chandra Mohan Medhi, the college's founding principal who served the college for a significant 27 years, the college rose to become a leading academic institution.

The college has gone a long way since it was founded; it has celebrated its Silver and Golden Jubilees and is currently getting ready for its approaching Diamond Jubilee celebration, which will commemorate the end of 60 years. The institution has its NAAC Accreditation to a B+ grade in 2019, thanks to the astute direction of the current Principal Dr. J. K. Hazarika. The smart classrooms, a digital recording room, a language lab, a computer centre, a GIS Lab, a fully equipped gymnasium, three conference halls, a sizable auditorium cum indoor stadium, and a fully functional canteen, a fully air-conditioned library, which includes a teacher's room are just a few of the upgrades the college is proud of. The college now has roughly 4000 students enrolled.

The college is presently equipped with the Science Stream, planning to offer B.Sc. to science aspirants from the academic session 2023–2024 with state-of-the-art science labs and new classrooms, in addition to Arts and Commerce at Higher Secondary and Undergraduate levels (UG). Other than these, the college also offers BBA (Self Financing Course) and courses under KKHSOU.

In recent years the college has signed MOUs with Gyalpozhing College of Information Technology, Bhutan, Balipara Foundation Assam, Kanaklata Civil Hospital Tezpur, LGB Regional Institute of Mental Health Tezpur, Mission Chariali Girls' School Tezpur, L.G.B. Girls' College Tezpur, etc. The College has adopted a village (Rudrapad), an orphanage (Naba Prabhat) and a School (Mission Chariali Girls' School).

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SECTION I ACADEMIC PROGRAMMES

HIGHER SECONDARY COURSE

Combination of Subjects for ARTS: Assamese, Adv. Assamese, Bengali, Adv. Bengali, Hindi, Adv. Hindi, Bodo, Nepali, English, Alternative English, Economics, Education, Political Science, Logic and Philosophy, Geography, History, and Environmental Studies.

English, MIL and Environmental Studies are compulsory for all. However, Alternative English can be taken in place of MIL (Assamese, Bengali, Bodo, Hindi & Nepali).

A student shall select any three subjects as core subjects and one as additional i.e. 4th subject (Each subject shall be of 100 marks).

Combination not allowed: Advanced languages, Logic and Philosophy are not allowed with Geography.

Combination of Subjects for COMMERCE: Assamese, English, Alternative English, Bengali, Bodo, Hindi, Nepali, Environmental Studies, Business Studies, Accountancy, Economics, Finance, Commercial Mathematics & Statistics.

English, Environmental Studies, Accountancy, Business Studies and MIL are compulsory.

Alternative English can be taken in place of MIL (Assamese, Bengali, Bodo, Hindi & Nepali).

Third and Fourth Elective Subjects (any two from the following) –

i) Economics ii) Finance iii) CMS

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Students seeking admission into H.S. 1st year may log into the "DARPAN" portal which has been made live from 29th May, 2023 to 17th June, 2023. Applications can be submitted online by visiting www.darpan.ahseconline.in or www.ahsec.assam.gov.in as per the notification by AHSEC dated 25th May, 2023. - Original documents must be produced on the date of admission along with the printed copy of online application form.
- Students seeking admission under ST/SC and OBC quota must produce their own original caste certificates.
- **Students** seeking free admission under OBC quota must produce non-creamy layer certificate.
- Students seeking admission under EC (extra curricular) quota must produce relevant original certificates.

All students seeking admission to our college have to register themselves on the DHE website: www.dheonlineadmission.amtron.in for generation of their UNIQUE ID, which they need to produce on the day of offline admission.





ADMISSION CRITERIA

- Admission will be strictly as per the Government rules and on Merit basis. The merit list will be available in the college website. Students need to check the Merit list and the message received from 'DARPAN' on their registered mobile number.
- 2. Selected candidate should take their admissions on the specified dates mentioned above, failing of which would fortify their claim.
- 3. A valid phone number of the candidate should be given. All communications will be done through this phone number.
- 4. A valid e-mail ID should be given.
- 5. On the day of admission, students must bring a scanned copy of the front page of the candidate's own bank account passbook (must be distinct), and give details of bank account as follows.
 - a) Name of the Bank account holder.
 - b) Bank account number.
 - c) IFSC number.
 - d) Name of the bank branch.
- 8. Student must furnish one of the following supporting documents to prove their domicile of Assam PRC/Voter ID/NRC/AADHAR Card/ passport of self or parent/BPL card/birth certificate issued by the Registrar of Birth and Death.
- 9. Once the bank details are submitted by the student, the same cannot be changed during their tenure in the college, otherwise they will be deprived from the Govt. beneficiary schemes. The student has to submit the necessary undertaking in this regard.
- 10. Annual income certificate of parents issued by Local Revenue Circle Officer.
- 11. Incomplete form or forms without documents will be rejected.
- 12. Admission Committee may refuse admission to a candidate whose documents are not genuine.
- 13. Subject combinations cannot be changed after admission.
- 14. A separate form will be issued for students claiming seats against Extra Curricular category. It must be filled up and submitted separately along with the necessary certificate and documents at the time of submission of the main application form for admissions. Only state and national level Certificates will be entertained for this category.
- 15. All admissions are governed by the College admission rules. The decision of the admission committee regarding admissions is final.

SECTION III RULES AND REGULATIONS

GENERAL RULES

- Students must abide by all the rules and regulations of the college. Students violating the rules and regulations are liable for disciplinary action like suspension and expulsion from the college.
- * Ragging or bullying, misconduct in any form, irregular attendance, and adopting unfair means in the examination, are considered serious offences and will lead to expulsion from the college.
- The Students' Union shall function under the guidance and control of the college authority.
- Societies, Associations or Clubs of Tezpur College will be subject to the guidelines and control of college authority.
- ❖ Any notice desired to be circulated or pasted must be countersigned by the Principal.
- ❖ Bringing identity cards to college is compulsory for all students. Duly filled registration forms should be submitted to the office within the stipulated time as fixed by the college office. No registration forms will be received after the stipulated time.
- For a pass certificate from the college, one has to apply one day ahead and for a transfer certificate, one has to apply at least two days ahead.
- Use of Mobile Phones, Smoking and Consumption of tobacco, alcohol, gutkha or any other intoxicants inside the college premises is considered a punishable offence.
- Entering the college premises without a uniform is strictly prohibited.
- Students must maintain the cleanliness of the college campus.
- Students' bicycles, motorcycles etc. must be parked at the allotted parking stands only.

ATTENDANCE RULES

Regular attendance in classes is a must. The minimum attendance in each subject must be 75% of the number of classes held in an academic session. A student having attendance less than 75% shall be declared non-collegiate.

EXAMINATION RULES

- College examinations are held according to the Academic Calendar.
- Internal assessments are conducted by the college.
- ❖ Internal assessments in every semester are compulsory for all. Students failing in the internal assessment of any subject or being absent in the same is considered Fail in that particular subject even if they get passing marks in that subject in the end semester examination held by the University.



COLLEGE UNIFORM

All students must wear the prescribed college uniform. Students who do not conform to the dress regulations will not be permitted to the college premises to attend classes.

STUDENT SUPPORT SYSTEM

- The college has a strong student support system which provides financial assistance to the needy & poor meritorious students.
- Best student award is given to the students securing the highest marks in the 6th-semester final examination from the college.
- ❖ ISAN UDAY Scholarship can be availed of by the students as per norms of the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India.
- ❖ National and State Merit scholarships can be availed by meritorious students of the college as per the Government norms.
- Scholarship for SC and ST students also can be availed by students of the respective communities as per norms of the Government.
- ❖ Kedermal Charitable Trust scholarship is awarded to 5 meritorious students of Arts and Commerce each in the first semester as per specified norms.
- Book Bank facility is provided to the economically backward students of the college as per specified norms through the college library.

CAREER COUNSELLING

The Career Counselling Cell provides regular counselling sessions on Career Opportunities, guidance on the pursuit of Higher Studies and training on personality development. This counselling is free of cost for our students.

STUDENTS' TRAVELLING CONCESSION

Bonafide students can avail travel concession through railway and govt. transport by producing valid documents.

HEALTH CHECK-UP FACILITY

The college arranges free health check-ups for students by a competent Medical Officer from time to time.

GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL CELL

The Grievance Redressal Cell has been set up to address the grievance and problems of the students reasonably.



NSS UNIT

The National Service Scheme (NSS) unit of the college is a Govt. of India-sponsored public service programme under the Ministry of Sports and Youth Affairs. It provides an opportunity for the students to take part in various govt. led community service activities and programmes. So through our NSS unit, students can get hand on experience in delivering community service.



At present, the NSS unit of Tezpur College has 100 numbers of Volunteers who are trained to understand their values of social and civic responsibilities. The unit attempts to establish meaningful linkages between 'college campus and community' and 'knowledge and action'. It is engaged in different programmes especially, Village Camps, Blood donation camps, Relief camps, Health and Sanitation drives, Plantation programmes, Adult education programmes, Awareness programmes and so on. SPORTS, HEALTH & FITNESS

To cater to the needs of those with a concern for health and fitness, the college offers a fully equipped unisex gym with a certified instructor. Training for sports such as body-building, weight-lifting, and other sports are available here. For those interested in various indoor sports, the college has also an indoor stadium within the college premises.





THE NATIONAL CADET CORPS (NCC) UNIT

NCC Cadets have reservations in many Government jobs, particularly in the Defense Services, Police services, Para-Military forces, Fire forces, BSF, Territorial Army, Industrial Security Forces, Public Sectors, and all uniform services. NCC cadets have a lot of academic incentives too. Seats at universities, for example, are reserved for NCC certificate holders. Similarly, many jobs give extra marks to the candidates having an NCC certificate.

Tezpur College, at present, has two NCC wings. One of which is a girl wing of The 78th Assam Battalion having 59 cadets and the other is under the 5th Assam Battalion for both boys and girls having 58 boys and 38 girl cadets. Both wings have brought many laurels to the college and the state. The NCC units of our college, which operate under the slogan "Unity and Discipline," seek to build organized, trained, and motivated youth by fostering leadership abilities, teamwork, a secular outlook, ideas of selfless service, and a spirit of adventure. The units offer their cadets the chance to participate in a variety of activities, with a clear focus on social services, discipline, and adventure training.



Any student willing to develop their skills and who wants to serve the country may join the NCC units of the college. Our cadets and Care Taking Officers (CTO) are actively taking part in the various activities of the society. They have organized and attended various Health camps, Tree plantation drives, Cleanliness drives, Blood Donation camps, and many other awareness programmes.



INFRASTRUCTURAL FACILITIES

CENTRAL LIBRARY: (Timing: 9.30 AM to 5.00 PM)

Our central library, the Chandra Mohan Medhi Library, is named in fond memory of ex-principal Late Chandra Mohan Medhi. It is a well-equipped, up-to-date computerized library with a collection of over 42000+ books covering a variety of disciplines and additional reading materials for the holistic development of an individual. The library has subscriptions to 15 nos. of reputed print journals, 18 nos. of magazines and 16 nos. of daily and weekly newspapers. In the year 2019, the college also launched an online institutional repository (with local storage) of its e-resources, from which users can access digitally stored question papers, books and journals published by the college, books authored by different faculty members and other college staff, and college magazines from various years. Users can visit this e-repository through www.tcelibrary.org.

At present, the library is using SOUL 3.0 software for its automation which is provided by UGC INFLIBNET. The barcode feature of our library further enhances the services offered by it. There is also the facility of a Kiosk computer, through which a student can search library books and e-resources very easily. Our library is a member of the N-LIST Project of INFLIBNET which provides e-books and e-journals online on a large scale. As a member of the N-LIST project the college can access 6000+ online-journal and more than 199500 e-books. Users can access these resources through http://nlist.inflibnet.ac.in.



Facilities-

- A library team provides a peoplecentred quality information service that helps users with their study and course projects.
- A separate Computer Workstation to explore the library's electronic resources and the internet.
- A student reading room with 130 seats that is fully air-conditioned.
- Fully air-conditioned reading room for teachers.
- Photocopiers, printers and scanners.
- The entire library is under CCTV surveillance.



Membership-

Students as well as staff of Tezpur College are entitled to free membership of the library upon registration as a library user. Students can enroll their library membership online through its library registration portal by visiting https://www.tcelibrary.org/students-registration and receive a library card.



Rules and Regulations of the Library-

- 1. Library cards are compulsory for getting access to the library.
- 2. Silence is to be maintained inside the library.
- 3. Library users have to put their signatures in the Library Attendance register at the time of entry and exit.
- 4. No personal belongings are allowed inside the library.
- 5. Students can borrow 2 books at a time for 15 days.
- 6. Reference books, periodicals and question papers will not be issued to the users.
- 7. Library Borrowers cards are not transferrable.
- 8. A sum of Re. 1/- per day shall be charged from the borrowers if a book is kept beyond the period of the loan.
- 9. Books lost, defaced or damaged in any way shall have to be replaced or the borrowers will have to bear the cost.
- 10. If a borrower's card gets lost or mutilated, it should be reported to the librarian immediately. A sum of Rs. 20/- will be charged for re-issuing a card.
- 11. Before receiving the admit card for the final examination, each final-year student is required to return their library books and library cards.
- 12. Using mobile phones and any other audio devices is strictly prohibited in the library.
- 13. The librarian may recall any book from any user at any time.



COLLEGE CANTEEN

The college canteen caters to the daily requirements of students and staff members. It provides hygienic and nutritious food at a reasonable price. It has separate dining rooms for students and staff members.



LANGUAGE LABORATORY

A Digital Language Laboratory is set up in the college to enhance the language-speaking skills of the students with the financial support of the UGC.

GIS LABORATORY

The Department of Geography is facilitated with a well-equipped GIS laboratory. ErDAS IMAGINE 13 and Super Map Deskpro version software is available in the laboratory along with quite a lot of Aerial Photographs, Scanner, Satellite Imagery, GPS and Plotter. The department also has smart classroom facilities.






CULTURAL MUSEUM

COMPUTER LAB

The Commerce Department of the college has a Computer Lab with 10 computers.



CONFERENCE HALL & AUDITORIUM

The college has a well-equipped Conference Hall with all modern facilities and a seating capacity of 300 people. Three state-of-the-art Seminar Halls raise the college to new heights. The college also has an auditorium cum indoor stadium within the campus.







GIRLS' HOSTEL

The Girls' Hostel of Tezpur College adds an advantage to the girls residing outside of their homes for the sake of education in our college like a 'home away from home'. It is situated within the campus and can accommodate 58 students. The rooms are allotted normally on a sharing basis. The hostel provides an ambient surrounding, spacious and well-furnished rooms with all basic amenities, and a disciplined environment along with 24-hour running water, generator facility and internet. The mess provides nutritious, home-cooked, balanced, hygienic and wholesome meals to the students. The college assures all parents that their daughters will be provided a peaceful, homely, disciplined and safe atmosphere.

The internal administration and discipline of the hostel is governed by the Warden, under the overall supervision of the Hostel Committee.



Criteria for Admission

- Only outstation students who have secured admission into regular courses of the college are eligible for admission to the Hostel.
- Admission into the hostel is strictly on a merit basis. It cannot be claimed as a matter of right.
 Seats for the reserved category are allotted as per government norms.
- The parents of the student selected for admission are required to appoint a responsible person as a local guardian to the satisfaction of the authorities. The local guardian will represent the parents and take charge of the ward in case of prolonged illness or unforeseen emergencies. At all times, the local guardian must be prepared to take charge of the ward and be available on the given telephone / mobile numbers. The college reserves the right to ask for a change of local guardian. Any change in local guardian requires prior approval of the college.
- The hostel remains non-functional during summer vacations/breaks and students will be required to make their arrangements for the stay.



Admission Procedure

Application forms for admission to the Hostel can be downloaded from www.tezpuronline.co.in. After admission to their respective courses, the student has to visit the website, then go to student profile -> apply for the hostel -> pay the non-refundable processing fee of Rs. 100 -> download the application form -> fill-up the form -> upload the filled form online -> deposit the hard copy at the college office by the schedule notified on the Notice Board or website of the College along with a print of the transaction ID of the processing fee of Rs. 100/-. Instructions for the documentation procedure are available on www.tezpuronline.co.in.

Candidates accepted for admission will be required to pay the requisite fees. If any candidate fails to pay the fees within the stipulated time, her admission will be nullified.

Admission to the 2nd and 3rd Year

Hostel admission in the 2nd and 3rd Year is done through fresh application. Students seeking readmission for successive years have to go through all the formalities applicable to new admission.

Hostel Rules and Regulations

- The admitted students are to report to the superintendent before boarding for the first time.
- 2. The boarders must maintain a decent, dignified and disciplined hostel lifestyle inside and outside the hostel. They must also maintain a decent dress code.
- 3. They must abide by the rules and regulations of the hostel as may be prescribed to them by the College authority, violation of which will lead to strict disciplinary action amounting to expulsion from the college.



- 4. Boarders must enter the hostel within the time fixed by the superintendent/warden for the summer and winter seasons and must be present in their respective seats at the time of Roll-Call.
- 5. Entertainment of guests and visitors is not allowed except with prior permission of the authority.
- 6. Visitors other than Legal/Local guardians are not allowed to meet the inmates of the hostel without the permission of the Principal.
- 7. Boarders must have to pay their Mess-Dues as may be fixed from month to month by the mess committee within the 10th day of every month.
- 8. Ill-treatment of co-boarders, cooks and other employees of the hostel is strictly prohibited.
- 9. The use of electrical equipment such as iron, heater etc. is not permitted.
- 10. The boarders must attend their classes regularly and must appear in all internal examinations and other academic activities of the college.





- 11. The boarders are to report the superintendent in writing for permission while leaving the hostel.
- 12. Boarders are allowed to leave the hostel for various purposes once a week fixed by the superintendent.
- 13. The students leaving for private tuition/coaching classes are to maintain a register showing the signature of their respective tutor/teacher.
- 14. During the study hour, boarders have to submit their mobiles.
- 15. All boarders must attend the evening yoga, physical activities and prayer.
- 16. Ragging or bullying in any form, either by seniors or juniors is prohibited and against the law. Also, the ragging or hazing of Freshers in any manner is strictly prohibited.
- 17. Use of narcotics, consumption of alcoholic beverages, gambling, smoking, etc. is strictly prohibited in the hostel. Any resident contravening the regulation will forfeit her right to hostel accommodation.




BICYCLE CLUB


