Report on the Feedback from Students


The students feedback for the year 2016-17, after analysis observed the following views of the students regarding the performance of the teachers as regards the curricular aspect:

4. The teachers according to the feedback has friendly disposition which made them approachable.


Recommendations/ Suggestions
